FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

This complaint came before the Nevada State Board of Certified Court Reporters ("Board") on January 28, 2019, with Board members Heidi Konsten, Lori Judd, and Peggy Elias present. Providing legal counsel for the Board was Sophia Long, Deputy Attorney General. The Executive Secretary was represented by counsel, Asheesh S. Bhalla, Deputy Attorney General. At the time of the hearing RESPONDENT, Jualita Stewart, License #807 appeared before the Board.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Based on testimony and exhibits admitted at the hearing, the Board found that the notice of Hearing had been sent by regular and certified mail to RESPONDENT'S last known home address on file with the Board, which is sufficient legal service pursuant to NAC 656.440(3).
- 2. The Board proceeded to hear and decide the matter based on the Board's finding that RESPONDENT was provided proper notice of the complaint pursuant to NAC 656.440(3).
- 3. RESPONDENT ("JUALITA STEWART"), CCR #807 was at the relevant times mentioned in this Complaint and Notice of Hearing, licensed by the Board as a certified court reporter subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provision of NRS Chapter 656 and NAC Chapter 656.
 - 4. On or about May 11, 2018 RESPONDENT received a renewed certified

court reporter's certificate from the State of Nevada.

- 5. On or about July 2, 2018 RESPONDENT took a deposition in the Discrict Court in Las Vegas, Nevada in Case NO.: A-17-751871-C.
- 6. On or about July 2, 2018, the Board received an email inquiring if "Ima rine Reporting" was registered with the Board.
- 7. On or about July 2, 2018 the Executive Secretary of the Board replie I to the email inquiry stating that "Imagine Reporting" is not registered with the Boar I.
- 8. On or about July 11, 2018, the Board emailed "Imagine Reporting" with a courtesy notice of non-registration.
- 9. On or about July 11, 2018, "Imagine Reporting" responded to the Board by stating they are not aware of state licensing requirements.
- 10. On or about July 13, 2018, the Board received confirmation via a phone call from "Imagine Reporting" that confirmed RESPONDENT reported on the July 2, 2018 deposition.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board, based upon the preponderance of the evidence, makes the following legal conclusions:

1. RESPONDENT is subject to discipline before the Board pursuant to NRS 656.250(9) for failing to comply with the requirements of NAC 656.320 when RESPONDENT engaged in the practice of certified court reporting for a non-registered firm.

2. RESPONDENT is subject to discipline before the Board pursuant to NRS 656.250(9) for failing to comply with the requirements of NAC 656.320 when RESPONDENT failed to verify whether the firm that solicited the reporting engagement was registered with the Board before engaging in the practice of cour reporting on behalf of the firm.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, by decision of the Board as follows:

- RESPONDENT, Jualita Stewart, License # 807, is assessed a fine of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250) for each violation referenced above, a total amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) and this fine must be paid on or before December 31, 2019.
- 2. RESPONDENT shall complete 6.0 continuing education credits in addition to the amount currently required for the calendar year. RESPONDENT shall also sub nit a signed affidavit stating that RESPONDENT has read NRS 656 and NAC 656. RESPONDENT shall submit said affidavit to the Executive Secretary on or before December 31, 2019;
- 3. The Board may institute collection and recovery actions against RESPONDENT if RESPONDENT fails to pay the costs and/or fines assessed above within the time given for payment.
