VOLUNTARY SURRENDER IN LIEU OF OTHER DISCIPLINE AND ORDER

This matter came before the Certified Court Reporters' Board of Nevada on June 24, 2013. Present were Board members Lori Judd, Peggy Elias, Peggy Hoogs, Severin Carlson and Christine Alaimo. Peggy Elias recused herself from hearing this matter. Rose Marie Reynolds, Deputy Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Board.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lisa Johnson ("Johnson") held Certificate of Registration No. 339 issued by the Certified Court Reporters' Board of Nevada ("Board").
2. On December 17, 2012, the Board sent Johnson Notice of Alleged Violation in Case No. NV 14-2012. The Notice alleged that by accepting the entire fee and paying a percentage to two court reporters who provided court reporting services to a Clark County courtroom, Johnson acted as a firm without being licensed. In addition, Johnson had an inactive court reporting certificate from the Board. The Board was investigating this complaint when Johnson surrendered her certificate.
3. On May 17, 2013, the Board notified Johnson that she was still subject to discipline for her conduct while she held her inactive certificate, that it would like to present her voluntary license surrender as a resolution of case No. NV 14-2012, and that if the Board accepts the resolution, the surrender would be considered disciplinary action in case No. NV 14-2012.
4. On June 24, 2013, Johnson told counsel for the Board that she accepted the proposed resolution of voluntary surrender in lieu of other discipline.


ORDER

The Board being fully apprised in the premises, and good cause appearing to the Board, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1 Lisa Johnson's voluntary surrender of Certificate of Registration No. 339 is accepted in
2 lieu of other disciplinary action in Case No. NV 14-2012 and Case No. NV 14-2012 is
3 resolved. Johnson cannot act as a court reporter in the state of Nevada until Johnson is
4 issued a new certificate of registration by the Board.
