Sec. 3. Any service or product offered or provided in a proceeding by a court reporter or firm to any party or to an attorney of any such party must be offered to each party or and to the attorney of each such party. The service or product offered or provided must be made available at the same time to each party in the proceeding, or their attorney. and the attorney of each such party. Sec. 4.

- 1. Any person who is not a party to a proceeding may request a copy of a transcript of a proceeding deposition or the video recording of a deposition from the court reporter or firm with possession of the transcript or video recording.
- 2. Upon receipt of a request described in subsection 1, the court reporter or firm shall notify each party to the proceeding deposition of the following:
- (a) That a copy of the transcript of the proceeding deposition or the video recording of the deposition is being sought by a third-party requestor;
- (b) The name of the third-party requestor. ; and
- (c) Information relating to any right of the party to obtain a court order prohibiting the provision of the transcript or video recording
