Sec. 4.

- 1. Any person who is not a party to a deposition may request a copy of the transcript of a deposition from the court reporter or firm with possession of the transcript.
- 2. Upon receipt of a request described in subsection 1, the court reporter or firm shall notify each party or the attorney of each party attending the deposition and the deponent at the deponent's last-known address or through the deponent's counsel of record of the following:
 - (a) That a copy of the transcript of the deposition is being sought by a third-party requester;
 - (b) The name of the third-party requester: and
 - (c) The right to seek a protective order.
- 3. Unless an order prohibiting the provision of the transcript of the deposition to the third-party requester is served on the court reporter or firm, not later than 60 days after the notification described in subsection 2, the court reporter or firm shall, upon receipt of payment of the current copy rate provide a copy of the requested transcript of the deposition to the third-party requester.
