## Certificate by Endorsement

NRS or NAC Definition: "Certificate by Endorsement" means a certificate to practice court reporting issued to a natural person within the jurisdiction of the United States, who has been certified as a court reporter or voice writer in a jurisdiction other than Nevada.

## NAC 656.XXX "Certificate by Endorsement" means a certificate to practice court reporting issued to a natural person under the provisions of this chapter.

- 1. Any natural person who is certified as a court reporter or voice writer in a jurisdiction other than Nevada may, with the approval of the Board, practice court reporting as a certified court reporter/voice writer. A natural person requesting the approval of the Board to practice court reporting under the provisions of this section of NAC shall submit to the Board:
  - a) An application accompanied by a fee of \$200 and all information as required under NRS 656.150 NRS 656.180 and NAC 66.150.
  - b) Documentation or other proof that the person has at least one continuous year of experience working full-time in the practice of court reporting; and
  - c) A copy of one of the following:
    - 1) A certificate as a Registered Professional Reporter, Registered Merit Reporter or Certified Realtime Reporter issued to the natural person by the National Court Reporters Association;
    - 2) A certificate as a Certified Verbatim Reporter issued to the natural person by the National Verbatim Reporters Association; or
    - 3) A corresponding valid and unrestricted license as a court reporter or voice writer in a jurisdiction in the District of Columbia or any state or territory of the United States that is substantially equivalent.
- 2. A natural person who is applying for a certificate by endorsement shall successfully pass a written examination in accordance with NRS 656.160 and NRS 656.170 prior to the issuance of a certificate by endorsement.
- 3. A natural person holding a certificate by endorsement may administer oaths and affirmations in accordance with NRS 656.315.
